### **Responsibilities**

- Provide referrals to mental and medical services in the city of New York.
- Work as part of a team, with other Advocates at Unique People Services (UPS) and with health care providers in clinical settings.
- Ability and willingness to accept direction from supervisor.
- Comfort with the diversity (ethnicity, sexual orientation, socioeconomic status, etc.) of our multicultural community.
- Maintain required work schedule, be on time, keep work area neat and be accountable for how time is used.
- Use good judgment regarding confidentiality issues.
- Advocate for tenants by bringing concerns about services to providers' attention.
- Help members identify risk reduction strategies (safe sex, drug treatment, needle exchange, etc.)

**QUALIFICATIONS:** To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. Basic computer proficiency required. Strong knowledge of serious mental illness & co-occurring physical health conditions, medical treatments and substance abuse issues required. High School Diploma/GED and one (1) year experience in peer advocacy and recordkeeping. Peer education training also required. Individual must have good oral and written communication skills; as well as good telephone skills. Must be honest and have a genuine compassion for individuals living with mental and physical disabilities. If addiction is an issue, must be clean and sober for at least one (1) year.
