SUMMARY: Responsible for the safe operation of the program and ensuring that all residents are provided with a safe and comfortable environment during the night/weekend shifts.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Monitor the overall operation of the program on the night/weekend shifts.
- Ensure that all house rules are adhered to by the residents.
- Provide support services to residents.
- Monitor and control the departure and arrival of all residents, guests and visitors
- Make regular checks of residential areas to ensure order and safety.
- Provide effective intervention to deal with crises.

QUALIFICATIONS: To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. Associates preferred, but may be substituted by a High School Diploma/GED in the human services field with experience working with the homeless, persons with HIV/AIDS, substance abusers, or the mentally ill, preferably in a congregate residential setting. Must be a computer literate team player with excellent client-contact and crisis intervention skills, and be willing to work nights and weekends. Spanish is a plus, as is a working knowledge of HASA and New York City low income housing mark. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
